### **2.1. Report Format**

For Parts 2-8, use the following format:

- The report should be a self-contained report in a continuous text format.
- Write your report on A4 sheets, double-spaced, 11-point font, Times New Roman, normal page margins (i.e., 2.5 cm from both top/bottom and left/right) and justified text (i.e., text should not be left aligned/centered, it should be distributed evenly between margins).
- All charts, diagrams, etc. can go to Appendix. This will save you space, if you need. Do not forget to refer them in the main body if you add them to Appendix.
- Use appropriate title and citation format (e.g., positioning, numbering etc.) for figures and tables within the text and Appendix.
- Do not forget to divide your report into parts. Use the headings and subheading given in this document. Add subheadings if you need more.
- Insert page number to your report.

- Make sure that your report has no grammar, spelling, and punctuation errors.
- Use proper technical terminology and a formal language.

- Add an appropriate titles for your appendices.
- Appendices should be placed on a new page.
